Syllabus for P.G. Diploma in Television Journalism
Entrance Test Examination 2021-22

Time: 1.30 Hours

Marks: 100

The Entrance Test for P.G. Diploma in Television Journalism will comprise of two parts- Part-A & Part-B.

1. Part-A will consist of 40 objective type multiple choice questions related to General knowledge & Current Affairs, Media awareness, Contemporary National and International issues, India and its neighborhood, Indian History, Society, culture & Politics, History of Television in India and current Television network press law, ethics of Journalism. Each Question contains one mark. There will be negative marking in Part-A with a weightage of 0.25 marks for each wrong answer.
2. Part-B will consist of Subjective type descriptive Questions with weightage of 60 marks consisting of 4 Questions of 15 marks each. Questions will be based on Current Affairs, Media & General awareness, Contemporary National and International issues, India and its neighborhood, Indian History, Society, culture & Politics, History of Television in India and writing skills for media.

Note: Admission to the P.G. Diploma in Television Journalism shall be done on the basis of merit determined by the result of Entrance Test Examination.
