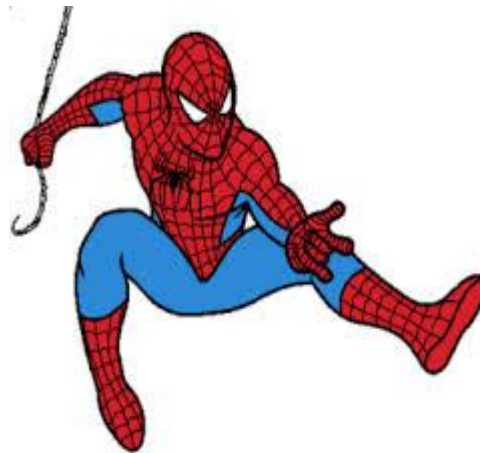

Daddy fell into the pond!



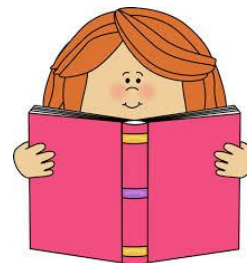
