- v. Write a paragraph on 'Investiture Ceremony' celebrated in your school on 04 May 2013.
- vi. Read lessons from your literature book i.e 'New Gems English Reader.' Prepare a skit with original dialogues based on any one lesson and get ready for a role play after the vacation.
- vii. Prepare your own questionnaire and conduct interviews of any two professionals like: doctor, teacher, lawyer, police man etc. Write the same in your magazine with related photographs.
- viii. Add some English crosswords, puzzles, word search games etc to make the magazine the more impressive and interesting.
