Detailed syllabus for the Entrance Test

**Part-A : Multiple Choice Questions**

Each Question carries one mark. The questions will be asked on the following subjects:

1. General Knowledge.
2. Social and Political issues.
3. Communication and Development.
4. Media for Development.
5. Development Programmes.
6. Research Aptitude.
7. Reasoning

**Part-B Drawing Skills (70 marks)**

This section will test the candidate's drawing and illustration skills. The tasks are intended to test the candidate's awareness of two and three dimensional space and composition as well as their physical drawing skills. We also test candidates' ability to sequence a story visually.

**Part-B (i) Visual Intelligence (40 Marks)**

This section tests the candidate's visual IQ through pattern and logic, using short type questions. This section tests the candidate's aptitude for a post-graduate program through short type questions and descriptive questions. The questions will cover their awareness of the field of computer graphics, animation and visual effects as well as their knowledge of current affairs, culture, literature, music, comics and film.

**Part-B(ii) Visualization, Comprehension and Writing Skills (70 marks)**

This is a subjective section that will test the candidate's ability to tell or imagine a story. Candidate will also be asked for analysis and viewpoints of situations.
