Make a word bank of new words you have read in the story and write their meanings too in an alphabetical order.

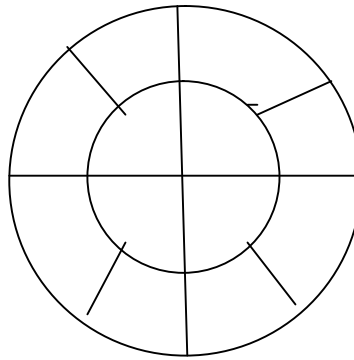
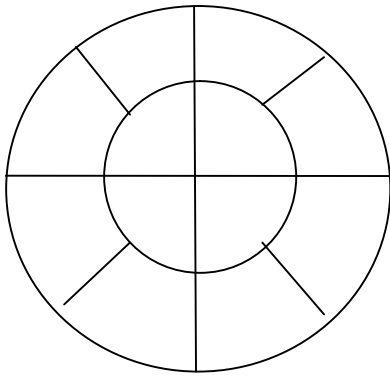
MATHMETICS
