

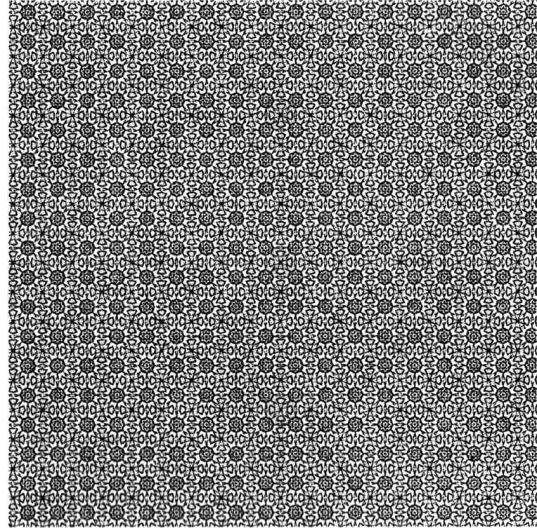
INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

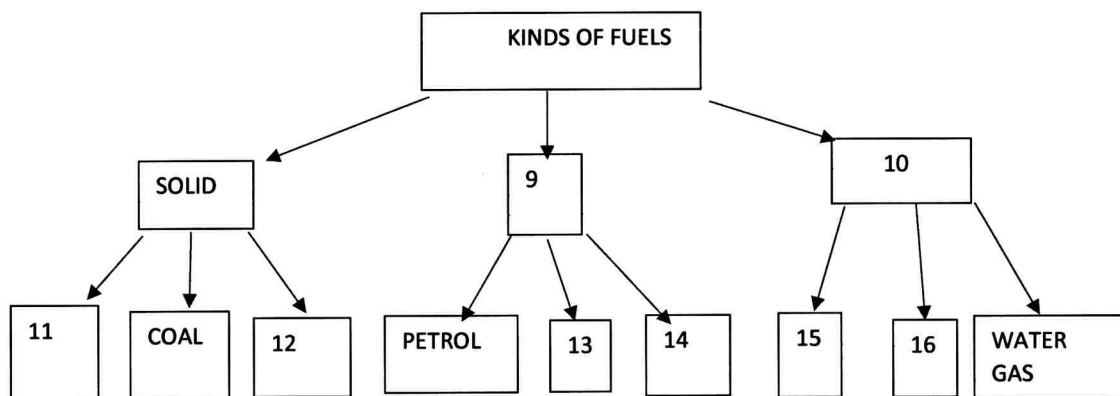

Fuels are materials that are burnt to produce a large amount of heat energy. A good fuel is one which is readily available. All matter in the universe is divided into solid, liquid and gas states. There are different kinds of fuels. Broadly they are classified based on the state in which it is available. They are divided into solid, liquid and gaseous fuels. Fuels which are found in their solid state at room temperature are generally referred as solid fuels. Solid fuels include substances such as wood, coal and coke.

Most liquid fuels are obtained from remains of dead plants and animals by exposure to heat and pressure, which is obtained from oil wells sunk deep into the earth. Petrol, Kerosene and Diesel are examples of liquid fuels. Gaseous fuels occur in nature and also manufactured from solid and liquid state. The most important gaseous fuels are natural gas, coal and water gas. Natural gas is a fuel that is widely used for cooking and heating.
